What can you expect when you come to the barn this Summer?

Have you seen our new handbook additions that we have created in an effort to keep riders, volunteers, and staff safe in these uncertain times? If not, the document is easily found on our website www.allstarfoundation.org at the top of each page just below the menu. We recognize that many of us are used to our regular procedures, and we want to ensure that each individual is aware and confident of these new practices.

- **All riders/volunteers/staff must sign the ASEF Handbook Additions Infectious Disease (COVID-19) before they are able to participate in any ASEF on-property activity.** Copies of the document will be provided, if you are unable to print and bring your own.
- Staff and volunteers will be wearing masks when they are unable to be farther than 6' away from other individuals.
- The office will be for staff and authorized personnel only. The door to the office is blocked by a table labeled 'Volunteer Check-in'.
- Riders, staff, and volunteers will have their temperature taken by a no-touch thermometer at the designated 'Volunteer Check-In'.
- Areas of the barn will be marked 'staff only' to ensure that cleanliness can be maintained. The tack room will remain locked.
- Benches have been moved under the trees out in front of the barn available to parents/caregivers/guardians. The bleachers by the arena are blocked, unable to be used.
- Parents/caregivers/guardians are to remain outside of the barn, unless they are a volunteer as well.
- Water will not be available from the water dispenser. Bottles of water may be purchased at the volunteer check-in for \$1. **Please bring your own personal water.**
